Dear Chairman Price and Ranking Member Diaz-Balart

As you begin crafting the fiscal year 2022 Transportation, Housing and Urban Development bill, I respectfully request that you give consideration to the following funding priorities:

Provide a funding level of \$83,900,000 for Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting Station Consolidation at DFW Airport as a community project funding request. The intended recipient is DFW Airport located at 400 Aviation Dr, DFW Airport, TX 75261

The project would be a valuable use of taxpayer funds because DFW airport placed a purchase of several snow and ice removal vehicle with Grant funds. The snow and ice removal fleet allows DFW to maintain airport operations during snow and ice weather events as experienced in February of 2021. The proposed facility is planned to meet the U.S. Department of Transportation Advisory Circular No: 150/522-18A BUILDINGS FOR STORAGE AND MAINTENANCE OF AIRPORT SNOW AND ICE CONTROL EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS. Currently the equipment parts in particular rubber hoses, tires, windshields, and paint finishes deteriorate faster due the high sun exposure in the Texas climate. This fleet storage facility will provide a climate-controlled enclosure to protect the equipment and extent the useful live of the equipment and its parts.
