Dear Chairman Price and Ranking Member Diaz-Balart

As you begin crafting the fiscal year 2022 Transportation, Housing and Urban Development bill, I respectfully request that you give consideration to the following funding priorities:

Provide a funding level of \$1,350,000 for West Continental Boulevard and South Peytonville Avenue Intersection Improvements as a community project funding request. The intended recipient is the City of Southlake, Texas.

The project would be a valuable use of taxpayer funds as it would
Increasing Mobility: AM peak hour level of services improved from E to B. Reducing Congestion: Peak wait time will be reduced significantly relative to existing conditions. AM eastbound peak reduced from 132 seconds to 12 seconds. Enhancing Safety: Roadway and pedestrian improvements to increase vehicular and pedestrian safety. Elementary school is directly adjacent to the project. Improvements to culvert crossing immediately west of intersection will alleviate existing intersection flooding. Improving Connectivity: Improved travel along Continental Boulevard, Peytonville Avenue, and surrounding roadways. Continental Boulevard serves as a parallel route to FM 1709 and is utilized by traffic from the surrounding communities of Keller and Colleyville.
