I am requesting funding for Heritage Ave in fiscal year 2024. The entity to receive funding for this project is City of Colleyville located at 100 Main St Colleyville, TX 76034.

The funding would be used on improving the safety of the roadway by replacing an aged and undersized culvert crossing just north of Cheek-Sparger Road. The project has received funding commitments from Tarrant County, the City of Euless and the City of Colleyville. Other improvements would include changes to the street vertical alignment improving sight distance, drainage, and better access to neighborhoods on each side of Little Bear Creek during high water storm events, along with additional lengths of sidewalk, and increased lighting.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it focuses on improving the safety of the roadway by replacing an aged and undersized culvert crossing just north of Cheek-Sparger Road. Other improvements would include changes to the street vertical alignment improving sight distance, drainage, and better access to neighborhoods on each side of Little Bear Creek during high water storm events, along with additional lengths of sidewalk, and increased lighting.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Federal Highway Trust Fund.
