Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting \$9,000,000 for the City of Keller Intersection Safety Improvements Project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Keller, Texas located at 1100 Bear Creek Parkway, Keller, TX 76248. The funding would be used to construct roundabouts at four intersections including Bourland and Bancroft Roads, Mt. Gilead Road and Robin Court, Whitley and Rapp Roads, and Keller Smithfield and Ottinger Roads. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because roundabouts reduce vehicle speeds, decrease conflict points at intersections, and significantly lower the number and severity of crashes while improving traffic flow and reducing driver delays.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 U.S.C. 133.
