Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting \$5,625,000 of funding for Brumlow Ave in fiscal year 2025. The entity to receive funding for this project is Southlake City Hall, located 1400 Main St, Suite 320, Southlake, Texas 76092. The funding would be used for the future widening of Brumlow Avenue from Continental Boulevard to State Highway 26 to its ultimate pavement section (four lanes divided). Bike lanes will also be constructed to facilitate connectivity to the Cotton Belt Trail through the city of Grapevine, Colleyville and North Richland Hills. The project will also include 2,200 LF of new sidewalk installation. This project will enhance mobility, expand route alternatives and meet future capacity demands in the Brumlow Avenue corridor as growth and development increases in the area. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because the City will be using taxpayer funds to ensure a safe and efficient roadway for motorists, bicyclists and pedestrian foot traffic.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by [23 USC 133\(b\)](#)
