Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting \$4,140,000 in funding for the City of Hurst Northside Pressure Plane 30-inch Water Main Project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is City of Hurst located at 1505 Precinct Line Rd Hurst, TX 76054. The funding would be used for the design and installation of a new 30-inch water main, connecting the existing 27-inch water main and unifying the northern and southern water pressure plains of Hurst. Additionally, funding would be used for the purchase of four water main pumps and rehabilitation of the interior and exterior of 3 above ground water storage tanks. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it allows the City of Hurst to be able to shut down pump stations for much needed maintenance, increasing capacity for providing water to the whole city.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C.5305(a)(2).
