Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting \$1,384,200 for the City of Hurst Sulphur Branch Drainage Improvements Project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Hurst located at 1505 Precinct Line Rd, Hurst, TX 76054. The funding would be used to extend the existing concrete-lined drainage channel and install additional rock riprap near the Sulphur Branch channel north of Rickel Park to stabilize storm drain outfalls and prevent erosion and sediment buildup. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will improve stormwater flow, reduce downstream flooding risks, protect drainage infrastructure, and enhance safety for residents and park visitors.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is consistent with purposes authorized in 42 U.S.C. 5305(a)(2).
