Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting \$3,000,000 for the City of Euless Reconstruction of Cresthaven Drive Project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Euless located at 201 N. Ector Dr, Euless, TX 76039. The funding would be used to reconstruct Cresthaven Drive from SH 10 to South Pipeline Road by replacing the existing two-lane asphalt roadway with a 31-foot-wide concrete street with curb and gutter. The project also includes replacing aging water lines along Cresthaven Drive between West Euless Drive and South Pipeline Road to improve water system reliability. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it upgrades aging infrastructure, improves roadway safety and drainage, reduces long-term maintenance costs, and prevents the need for future roadway excavation to repair utilities.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 U.S.C. 133.
