Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting \$1,100,000 for the Forest Ridge and Cheek Sparger Road Intersection Upgrades and Traffic Signal Project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Colleyville, located at 100 Main Street, Colleyville, TX 76034. The funding would be used to install a traffic signal and complete intersection upgrades at the intersection of Forest Ridge Drive and Cheek Sparger Road, a minor arterial identified in the City of Colleyville Master Thoroughfare Plan. The city is currently in the preliminary design phase for the reconstruction of Cheek Sparger Road, and a traffic study conducted in conjunction with this effort has determined that signalization at this intersection is warranted. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will improve traffic safety and mobility at a critical intersection, support ongoing corridor improvements, and address increasing traffic demands in a growing area.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 U.S.C. 133.
