Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro:

I am requesting \$16,137,500 for the City of Southlake Brumlow Avenue Project in fiscal year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Southlake located at 1400 Main Street, Southlake, TX 76092. The funding would be used to widen Brumlow Avenue into a four-lane divided arterial between State Highway 26 and FM 1709, including sidewalks, dedicated bike lanes, and a connection to the regional Cotton Belt Trail. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will improve regional mobility, reduce congestion, enhance pedestrian and cyclist safety, and support multimodal connectivity between surrounding communities and DFW Airport.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 U.S.C. 133.
